## **Forest Heights Police Apprehend Attempted Murder Suspect**

On September 20, 2010 at 9:01 p.m. Forest Heights Police patrol units responded to Miles Drive and Modoc Lane for a fight. Shortly after the officer arrived on the scene the Suspect opened fire at the officer and the caller with an AK-47 assault rifle.

The suspect had been stopped by the police that night, but the witness did not identify him as the shooter until after he had been released. Officers quickly obtained a warrant.

On September 21, 2010 at 6:54 p.m. the same officer who was fired upon observed the suspect on Livingston Terrace and stopped him. The suspect was taken into custody and arrested.

Bruce Timothy Shelton, 51, was charged with attempted murder, assault on a law enforcement officer, and reckless endangerment, among other charges.
